## ccd reminders

Just as a reminder, CCD resumes on Wednesday, January 11. This means that there are no classes this week. Parents should take a good look at the CCD calendar for this spring session. This especially applies to those who have children preparing to celebrate the Sacraments of First Reconciliation, Holy Communion and Confirmation. There will be important, mandatory parent meetings in February. If you have misplaced your calendar you may get another copy through the CCD office or by going online and downloading it from the parish website. Regarding Confirmation students, there are still a few who have not completed the fall service hours. As difficult as these may be, let it be clear that if a student in Confirmation class has not completed his/her service hours, and/or missed three classes, they will not receive the Sacrament this year. The requirements are so minimal that it is hard to justify not even completing them on time. Let this serve as a “last chance” reminder for those who have been neglectful as of now. Not to over-simplify matters, but it is in reality about one’s priorities.

## new offering envelopes

As of this weekend all parishioners who utilize offering envelopes should have received theirs through the mail. If you did not receive them and have questions call the parish office. As far as changes in address or names, it will take two months notice to the company to accomplish this in the future, so as to secure the new ones being properly addressed.

## extraordinary ministers of the eucharist

It is important to refresh our mindset concerning our duties with this ministry—especially concerning those after Mass is concluded. Extraordinary Ministers are to clear the credence table of the sacred vessels, and perform the necessary purification. To purify the sacred vessels, use fresh water, fill the cup, consume the water (**never** pour it into the sacrarium—lidded sink) and then thoroughly dry the vessel using a fresh, clean purificator from the drawer in the sacristy. Ministers are as well to empty the Lavabo (handwashing) bowl, dry it, and place a new hand towel with it for the next Mass. After the 10 A.M. Mass, the ministers are to cleanse and purify the vessels, and then put all of them into their respective cabinets. Those extraordinary ministers at the 6 P.M. and 8 A.M. Masses are to make sure and have the vessels ready for the next Mass.
