proposition 2 to amend the texas constitution

On Tuesday, November 8, Texans will be asked to vote on Proposition 2 to amend the Texas Constitution prohibiting the legalization of same-sex unions in Texas. A “yes” vote for Proposition 2 says one is against same sex unions and is in favor of prohibiting legalization of same-sex unions in Texas. A “no” vote will make it so the amendment does not take place, thus making it easier to allow same-sex unions in Texas in the future. The U.S. bishops have addressed the issue of marriage and same-sex unions in various documents at the national level stating that marriage is a lifelong union between one man and one woman.
