Tuesday – Chrism Mass

10:00 a.m.- Our Lady of Victory Cathedral/Victoria - this is the Mass in which Bishop Fellhauer will consecrate Sacred Chrism for the upcoming year, and bless the Oil of the Sick and Oil of Catechumens for the upcoming year. It is also the time which the priests of the diocese renew their priestly ministry.

Thursday – Evening Mass of the Lord’s Supper

- 7:00 p.m. at St. Patrick’s
- the new oils will be received and placed in the ambry
- The washing of the feet
- Transfer of the Eucharist and adoration from after Mass until 10:00 p.m. – Heritage Rm.
The faithful are encouraged to come spend some time with the Lord as we prepare for Good Friday.

Friday –Stations of the Cross

9:00 a.m. Meet at St. Patrick’s Hall for trip to Placedo to walk Stations of the Cross back to Bloomington.

The Good Friday Collection

On Good Friday, our parish will take up the annual collection for the Holy Land. Your financial contribution will support the works of the Catholic Community in the Middle East and to protect the Holy Places and Christian Shrines.

From the daily news we know the challenges in the Middle East. Christians in the Holy land urgently need our help and you can help fellow Catholics through the generosity during this second collection.

Holy Oils*

The Holy Oils blessed by Bishop Fellhauer will be placed in our Ambry, the receptacle located just to the left of the altar on the wall. They will be used throughout the year in the parish for the sacraments:

- Oil of Catechumens – those approaching baptism
Oil of Infirm or Sick – those who are seriously ill
Oil of Sacred Chrism – Baptism and Confirmation (and is used in Holy Orders)

* Oil is a product of great utility the symbolic signification of which harmonizes with its natural uses. It serves to sweeten, to strengthen, to render supple; and the Church employs it for these purposes in its rites.

Holy Water

There will be no Holy Water in the fonts of the church from Holy Thursday evening after Mass until the new waters are blessed at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday.
