## vigil candles information

Many will have noticed by now the smaller “jarred” candles on the vigil stand as well as in the sacristy cabinet for home use. They are still 5 day candles, like the previous ones, but the company providing them now uses a compressed wax method that removes a lot of the air in the regular candle. It should be the same amount of “burn time” with a shorter, slightly thicker candle. At present they are still available for an offering of \$2, but with rising fuel costs for delivery, it is quite possible the price will increase in the future.

## a little housekeeping....

As is quite normal, most families prefer to schedule Masses for loved ones on weekends when they are free from work and more members of the family can attend together. One issue has arisen during these last two months that needs to be addressed. Masses will not be scheduled over the phone any longer. Nor will dates be scheduled after Sunday Mass as it is difficult to know if a date is available when the calendar is in the office and the priest is standing with you in the Church. This must be done in person at the office, in advance of the date desired. Simply call ahead to assure I will be here so you do not make the trip and find the office closed. The offering for any Mass—weekday or Sunday—is \$5. It should be given at the time of scheduling the Mass. There have been numerous examples during these last two months of individuals who have hounded the office for a specific date, called to check up on that date, and then never made the customary offering either beforehand or after the Mass. If a family cannot afford the offering, they should indicate this at the time of the scheduling.
