## a few housekeeping items...

Offering envelopes are a method for those who keep track of their weekly offerings for tax purposes to do so. Aside from this main purpose, they are not a necessity, and are an added expense for the parish (approximately \$950 annually). Starting in 2006 we will be changing our envelope provider, as increased costs have caused us to look for more practical and inexpensive methods to provide these items for those who utilize them. For 2006 envelopes will be mailed directly to the homes, and will come bi-monthly. As to calendars...calendars will be mailed to all registered parishioners in December. The calendars are also an added yearly expense (\$650) which are not always appreciated and sometimes, even discarded [as banks and grocery stores also give out calendars]. If there is no feedback on the issue of calendars, we may discontinue them after this year. As to the outdoor carpet at the entrance of the Church, plans are in the works to have “santillo tile” (like that on the rectory and office porch) put in its place. The expense that this project will add may mean waiting until the spring. Although the carpet is definitely an eyesore, we can surely live with it just a while longer. Remember: it is always easy to criticize, it is much more challenging to become part of the solution...especially concerning singing.
