## offering envelopes

The use of offering envelopes is primarily an accounting issue, especially at tax time. They also pose a major expense for the parish and require more efforts in bookkeeping. If someone has requested them in the past and not used them--or used them and the **ANNUAL** "Church Support" donations do not exceed \$75 (**TOTAL for the entire year**)-they will not be issued a set for 2006. It is hard to justify the great expense and time these items require under such circumstances. If you do not receive envelopes and have some concerns, simply call the parish office.
