As it is that time of year again when our loan is evaluated and adjusted according to the changing annual interest rate...the remainder we owe on our office building loan is now \$89,195.08. The interest rate is 6.75%. Each month we pay \$2,890.23 (\$2,388.51 on the principal and \$501.72 on interest). We have 34 more payments to make. Fortunately as the months go by the interest payments decrease as more is applied against the principal.
