ccd news

We are already past the halfway point of summer and it is time to begin looking ahead at the calendar for some important CCD dates to remember. CCD registration will be held on the last two Wednesday evenings of August (August 24th and 31st) from 6:30 P.M. until 8 P.M. This will be the only time registration will be held. We are hoping to have CCD classes for grades 1-12. If however we are short of teachers, some classes will be cut. If it does come to that situation, we will make sure and provide the books for home schooling (this does not apply to sacramental classes as we know already that there are teachers for First Communion and Confirmation). Registration fee is again \$15 per child payable at registration (no checks please). As has been the case in recent years, no child will be turned away for the inability to meet the registration fee. Those parents who find themselves in this situation should mention this privately to Father when registering. The first day of CCD is Wednesday, September 14. As we have had good success these past two years, we will continue the practice of having all CCD classes on Wednesday evenings. And for those registering for Sacramental classes...if the child was not baptized at St. Patrick's then the parents should bring a copy of the child's baptismal certificate (not birth certificate) with them to registration. Please make sure and get the word out so that we can get things organized and running smoothly.
