For those who have been putting off this grace-filled moment for their child or children, now is the time to make a commitment. As a side note, children attending CCD should be baptized as well. There will be no class in September due to the Turkey Dinner.

ccd registration and information

CCD registration will be held on the last two Wednesday evenings of August (August 24th and 31st) from 6:30 P.M. until 8 P.M. This will be the only time registration will be held. We are hoping to have CCD classes for grades 1-12. If however we are short of teachers, some classes will be cut. If it does come to that situation, we will provide the books for home schooling. Registration fee is again \$15 per child payable at registration (no checks please). As has been the case in recent years, no child will be turned away for the inability to meet the registration fee.
