parish hall rentals

As a reminder, the parish hall is rented only to parishioners. It is done this way in hopes that those who are already supporting the parish will understand and responsibly maintain this important part of our parish plant. It is available for anniversaries, reunions, wedding receptions, etc. It is not rented for fundraising events or wedding ceremonies. Registered parishioner rental fee is \$350, and non-registered parishioner rental is \$425. A date is secured by a signed contract and \$100 deposit (returned if there is no damage to church property).
