Third Week of Advent

This week brings the **O Antiphons**, as we enter into this octave (eight days) before Christmas. Each one highlights a title for the Messiah: *O Sapientia* (O Wisdom), *O Adonai* (O Lord), *O Radix Jesse* (O Root of Jesse), *O Clavis David* (O Key of David), *O Oriens* (O Rising Sun), *O Rex Gentium* (O King of the Nations), and *O Emmanuel*. Also, each one refers to the prophecy of Isaiah of the coming of the Messiah. As a matter of fact, if you take each of the first letters of the Latin title backwards you spell ERO CRAS, which means 'Tomorrow I will come!' Go back each day and reflect on how God comes to you in Jesus Christ in each of these ways.
