Ash Wednesday: the beginning of Lent

This Wednesday we will begin the Lenten season. Masses will be celebrated at 8 A.M. and 7 P.M. with distribution of ashes.

Prayer: Stations of the Cross

Fasting: Days to be observed in Lent

All Catholics in good health are obliged to fast and abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. All Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence from meat as well. This ancient practice of the faith allows us to engage sacrifice and grow in our understanding of the Lenten mysteries we celebrate.

Almsgiving: Operation Rice Bowl

The annual program for charitable work includes the Operation Rice Bowl. The bowls are in the entrance of the Church for you to take home and utilize. They should be returned at Easter with the monies saved through fasting and offered in charity to help those less fortunate.
