Wireless cellular Tower

As has been addressed at organization meetings, the parish has been approached by Cingular Wireless to lease the back portion of the Church's property for a cellular tower. All seems to be ready to go. This will be a great asset to the parish, as the income from the lease can help us meet some of the larger annual expenses the parish incurs, such as with our Diocesan Assessment (DSA). Our assessment for 2006 is approximately \$13,000. The lease income for each month is \$500 (\$6,000 a year). Although we are starting this at the almost mid-year point, it will help us meet our assessment. Coupled with the annual raffle we do in February as in years past, we should be able to meet this expense--and then some. This leaves our parish Spring BBQ and Fall Turkey Dinner to help pay our property insurance (\$17,000-\$18,000) and other large annual expenses.

The diocesan attorney, finance officer, and our Bishop are in favor of allowing us to enter this lease. The company leasing has plans to erect the tower perhaps by the end of August or so.

You may already have seen the surveying stakes, and in coming weeks, there should be a little more work done. This will prove to be a long-term lease that will financially benefit the parish. Simply to update you on what's been in the works....
