I want to thank those who have kept me in their prayers during my travels (to and from) and stay in Washington, D.C. The month of review and study finally concluded with the hour-long comprehensive oral exam boards. I am most grateful to all who went “above and beyond the call of duty” in helping with the administration of the parish in my absence at Catholic University of America these past weeks.

Unlike previous years upon my return, this year will be marked by transition as I prepare to transfer to my new parish and you prepare to receive your new pastor.
