

A reflection from the Pastor

“Rise, take the child and his mother, flee to Egypt, and stay there until I tell you. Herod is going to search for the child to destroy him. Joseph rose and took the child and his mother by night and departed for Egypt.

Rise, take the child and his mother and go to the land of Israel, for those who sought the child’s life are dead.” He rose, took the child and his mother, and went to the land of Israel.

And you thought you were tired from Christmas traveling! The work of Joseph in caring for the Holy Family must have been tremendous. His husband and fatherly care was all about the protection of Mary and Jesus, first in departing to Egypt and then in returning to Israel. As you notice, at each moment of danger, Joseph listened to God through his messenger angel. Listening to the Word of the God is most important in family dynamics. As you may have heard more popularly, ‘the family who prays together stays together’ – we might adapt to ‘the family who reads the Bible together grows in God’s ways.’

As many of you know, my patron saint is St. Joseph. I still remember a prayer that has come to mean different things to me over the length of my life. I began praying it back in high school.

St. Joseph, foster Father and protector of virgins,
To whom God entrusted Jesus and Mary,
I implore you by the grace which did bear them
To preserve me from every defilement of soul and body
Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

I commend this prayer to all fathers. Let us pray for the strength of the family in our day. So many forces seem to be against the union of families – but there are so many for them – Jesus, Mary, and Joseph and the Holy Spirit that enables us to live and move and have our being.
