Peace.

"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light" Jesus in today's gospel.

There is no doubt that Jesus offered and offers a freedom from this world – a freedom for eternal peace and happiness. He was speaking about being burdened by the law [which the scribes and Pharisees were all about]. Yet, Jesus' yoke is not solely of the law, but of obedience to his word, through which one will find rest.

How often we burden ourselves with things that really count for very little in the plan of salvation. How many times, we let the words of Television, Radio, Newspaper, Magazines, consume our thoughts and reason – and make us jump to illogical conclusions. In other words they can act as a yoke, a means of holding us back from the Truth, that does not lead to authentic freedom. Try this week to replace some of those "busy" things with the Word of God. Set aside ten minutes a day to read the words of Jesus in the New Testament.

In that way we take on the yoke of obedience and listen to His voice. It is so easy to listen to all the other voices, even our own. Take some time this week to focus on His voice and His Truth.
