Peace.

Jesus said to his disciples: "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father in heaven," in today's gospel.

This really has to make us wonder, what is enough? What is the will of the Father?

All of our life is a response to the will of the Father. To the extent that we participate with his Holy, Divine Will, we make our lives that much easier. For instance, if all we do throughout our day is gather more goods and wealth for ourselves, to go out and spend foolishly on the weekends and not give back one hour to God, then we are not honoring the will of the Father. Another example, do you spend more time thinking about how to decorate the outside of your body than the inside? Another: Do you think more about helping yourself or others? Another: When you help others, are you thinking about what you will get in return or about praising God? These are all legitimate questions that we must ask ourselves. To do the will of the Father, means to put on the mind and heart of Jesus and strive to walk in his ways as best we can each day. Jesus says, the will of the Father is that he should not lose anything of what he gave, but that he should raise it on the last day. Do we work toward that raising by denying ourselves the things we think we need, but really don't need?

Try this week to focus on your response to the will of the Father, hopefully, not at the expense of others, but for the betterment. You will find your life freer and more fulfilling.
