

## A reflection from the Pastor

The whole law depends on the love of God and the love of neighbor, Jesus tells us in today's gospel. In answering the question: "which commandment is the greatest," Jesus gave an answer that asked the scholar to go deeper in his understanding of what is truly great – God.

This relationship of love that Jesus asks us to build finds its fulfillment in the cross. Jesus' love for the Father (vertical relationship) and his love for his neighbor, namely the repentant thief and the salvation of the world (horizontal relationship) is the cross. Jesus showed what it means to love by dying on the cross to save our souls.

In our own relationships, we are called to die to our selfishness and see our neighbors in love. When we allow ourselves to realize the love of God in one another, then we have choice to carry our crosses and forego our egos and personal desires for the sake of Christ and the Church.

Take some time this week to meditate on how you are living and walking with the cross daily by the love you show to God and neighbor.
