Liturgical Update – Pronouncing God's Name in the Liturgy

From time to time, I like to bring you news on liturgical directives. The Vatican recently (August 8) issued a directive concerning the use of "the Name of God" in liturgical celebration. The title "Yahweh" may no longer be "used or pronounced" in "liturgical celebrations, songs, or prayers." This stems from the church's official liturgical texts following ancient Jewish tradition. As a gesture of respect for God's divine revelation, the "proper name" of God is not written or spoken. In Hebrew the name is represented by the tetragrammaton or four consonants: YHWH. The Greek translation renders it "Kyrios" or "Lord." Most contemporary translations use phrase "the Lord." What this means for us is that those songs currently in our hymnals using a refrain or verse with "Yahweh" in will have to be omitted. These would include: "Yahweh" by Gregory Norbet, "You are Near" and "Sing a New Song," by Dan Schutte.
