Saint of the Week
Saint Gregory the Great



Born c. 540 in Rome, Italy. Son of Gordianus, a Roman *regionarius*, and Saint Silvia of Rome. Nephew of Saint Emiliania and Saint Tarsilla. Great-grandson of Pope Saint Felix III. Educated by the finest teachers in Rome, Italy. Prefect of Rome for a year, then he sold his possessions, turned his home into a Benedictine monastery, and used his money to build six monasteries in Sicily and one in Rome. Benedictine monk. Upon seeing English children being sold in the Roman Forum, he became a missionary to England. Elected 64th Pope by unanimous acclamation on 3 September 590, the first monk to be chosen. Sent Saint Augustine of Canterbury and a company of monks to evangelize England, and other missionaries to France, Spain, and Africa. Collected the melodies and plain chant so associated with him that they are now known as *Gregorian Chants*. One of the four great Doctors of the Latin Church. Wrote seminal works on the Mass and Divine Office, several of them dictated to his secretary, Saint Peter the Deacon. Died March 12, 604 in Rome of natural causes. He is the patron saint of choir singers, educators, masons, students, and against gout.

A reflection from the Pastor

"Nothing that enters one from outside can defile that person; but the things that come out from within are what defile," Jesus in today's gospel. This saying is important, because Jesus shows us what it means to have free will, the capacity to choose how we respond to that which seeks to defile us from within. So often, we want to blame our sins on the T.V. or on the internet or on what someone told us to do, and yet in each act, we have the power to choose Christ or to choose deceit or evil. Try this week to find yourself making good choices from within, not blaming the outside world; in doing so you will be able to discern more clearly the Father's will.
