Today we celebrate the feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. It is fitting that following the birthday of Jesus, we look at the holy family; for it was the love of his parents - Mary and Joseph - that cared for Jesus during his infancy, childhood, and those years preceding his public ministry. We might even wonder, what was Jesus like as a baby, what was he like as a teenager, what was he like as a young adult? While we know he was about his father's business from the age of about twelve (Luke 2:49), the gospel tells us that he was also obedient to Mary and Joseph who raised him (Luke 2:51). Remember, Jesus was like us in all things but sin. He did not sin, but he went through the same growing up processes that each of those stages of life bring.
