"Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while," Jesus in today's gospel. There is no doubt that the early apostles walked a tough road. People were coming to them, so much so they didn't even have time to eat. Jesus, seeing their need, taught them to make time for themselves and for the Lord, even in ministry-especially in ministry.

Saint Mary Magdalene



Friend and follower of Jesus. She was filled with sorrow over her sin, she anointed Christ, washing his feet with her hair. Jesus exorcised seven demons from her. She was visited by the Risen Christ.

It is believed she died in Ephesus of natural causes. Her relics were transferred to Constantinople in 866 where they remain today.

She is patron saint against sexual temptation, converts, pharmacists, women, perfumers, hairdressers, and penitent sinners.

Baptisms are held the first Sunday of each month except during the seasons of Advent and Lent.

Birth certificate of child is required before baptism.
