Traditionally, the month of October is the month of the rosary. The feast of Our Lady of Rosary is October 7th, also known as the feast of Our Lady of the Victory. This feast grew out of the Christian victory over the Turkish fleet at the battle of Lepanto on October 7, 1571. The victory was credited to the rosary, after the Christians turned to Mary for help. This is also the feast of the mother church of our diocese, Our Lady of Victory Cathedral. The rosary is a powerful aid in our own daily lives. Take time this month to pray the rosary with your family or alone.

As in past years, I will be on vacation during October. This means the office will be closed and there will be no daily Masses. Msgr. Peter from Holy Family in Victoria will be filling in for Sunday Masses and emergency calls. Please welcome him and assist him as needed. How to Pray the Rosary

1. Make the **Sign of the Cross** and say the "Apostles' Creed."
2. Say the "Our Father."
3. Say three "Hail Marys."
4. Say the "Glory be to the Father."
5. Announce the First Mystery; then say the "Our Father."
6. Say ten "Hail Marys," while meditating on the Mystery.
7. Say the "Glory be to the Father."
8. Announce the Second Mystery; then say the "Our Father." Repeat 6 and 7 and continue with Third, Fourth and Fifth Mysteries in the same manner.
9. After the rosary, pray the Hail, Holy, Queen and final prayers, ending with the sign of the cross.

Final Prayers:

V. Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God.
R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ. Let us pray. O GOD, whose only begotten Son, by His life, death, and resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech Thee, that meditating upon these mysteries of the Most Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ Our Lord. Amen.

Joyful: Annunciation, Visitation, Birth of Jesus, Presentation in Temple, Finding of Jesus in Temple
Sorrowful: Agony in Garden, Scourging at Pillar, Crowning with Thorns, Carrying Cross, Crucifixion
Glorious: Resurrection, Ascension, Descent of Holy Spirit, Assumption of Mary, Coronation of Mary
Luminous: Baptism of Jesus, Wedding at Cana, Proclamation of the Kingdom, Transfiguration, the Eucharist
