

## A reflection from the Pastor

Today's gospel question over the issue of divorce is one that still continues in our own time. Ultimately, one who divorces is not outside of the Church's communion. Following Sacramental confession, if necessary, the persons are still able to receive Holy Communion and the Sacraments. When one remarries, outside the laws of the church following a divorce, they commit adultery and even further, they lead their spouse into adultery also. It is then, that they are taken out of communion, until their marriage is validated through the annulment process or death of spouse (s). One might wonder why this issue seems so intense. The short answer is that, in the eyes of the Church, there is only one marriage. In heaven, we will all be married to Christ – we will all be his bride. Christian marriage witnesses to the union of love in Christ, for Christ, for all eternity. Otherwise, as in the case of adultery, it becomes a habit of sin. What to do if you find yourself in such a situation? Pray, seeking the guidance of the Holy Spirit. Seek out a priest to help rectify your situation and do it soon. Don't let years pass by in which you are outside the Sacraments, especially the Eucharist.
