"My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me," Jesus in today's gospel. As Good Shepherd, Jesus provides for his sheep – knowing them completely, like a shepherd would know his own flock in the pasture. When the sheep, asleep, or entangled with another herd, hear the voice of the shepherd, they rise and follow him.
