



A reflection from the Pastor

"Master it is good that we are here," St. Peter speaking to Jesus at the moment of the Transfiguration. According to conventional wisdom, Peter had it at least partially correct in wanting to remain in the moment. One of the things we are taught in seminary is to remain in the moment, to be present to the situation. But God the Father moved Peter to his own transfiguration by helping him to realize the bigger picture – his kingdom in heaven. It was after all the Father who sent His only Son to save the world. The voice of the Father reminds Peter to focus on listening to Jesus, not just in getting fixed on the moment. This is a valuable lesson for us this Lent. We can become so fixed on ourselves and the moment of conversion, that we forget conversion continues each and every day until the glory of heaven. Yes, we need to be present to the moment, but we also need to be moving in the direction of listening and finding Jesus in that moment and beyond.

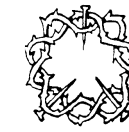

Diocesan Services Appeal 2010

By now you have received at your homes the pledge cards from the diocese regarding the 2010 Diocesan Services Appeal. The monies collected go toward the programs and services, salaries and operational expenses of the Chancery of the Bishop, which this year will total \$1,349,808. Each parish in the diocese has a goal for each year, which is calculated by averaging three years of parish collections (first). **This year the goal for St. Patrick's is \$21,170.** This is up \$2,434.93 from last year which was \$18,735.07. I encourage you to give. Any money given will offset the amount the parish owes at the end of the year. Last year, individual contributions totaled \$1,255.00. May God bless you in your generosity.

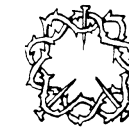
This week's question:
