

## A reflection from the Pastor

"And a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased:" Saint Luke speaking of Jesus' baptism in today's gospel.

The words of the Father, 'you are my beloved Son' round out this Christmas season. And Jesus' baptism demonstrates that God's plan of salvation comes through Jesus and the sacraments; baptism being the gateway to the other sacraments of Confirmation, Eucharist, Reconciliation, Marriage, Holy Orders, and Anointing of the Sick. To be pleasing to the Father is the task of every human being; not that God needs us for him to be pleased, but that His creation would find it's way to Him through Jesus and life of the sacraments is pleasing. The descent of the Holy Spirit upon Jesus at his baptism further shows God's Almighty Presence.

For each of us, baptized into Christ Jesus, we are called to make our lives pleasing before the Father. One of the prayers of the Rite of Baptism is that the new life (garment) of Christ in the soul, be brought unstained into the dignity of everlasting life in heaven. That is what we walk with each and every day and every season of the Church's life, until finally our body dies and our soul, which has so been expanded by the life of grace, continues into the mystery of God's presence forever in heaven. Pray this week that you will re-commit to your baptismal promises and make your life pleasing to the Father.
