

**A reflection from the Pastor**

"Peace be with you," Jesus' words to the disciples in today's gospel. Twice Jesus tells them this as they are locked in the upper room, fearful for their lives and what will happen next. Jesus was just crucified for what he professed, and they are fearful that they will be next on the list. So Jesus' statement is meant to allay their fears, and then he gives them more encouragement: they are to receive the Holy Spirit – and with that comes the act of forgiving sins. This is the way to true peace in our own day -- to be able to forgive one another. Many times we hold on to the sins of others or harbor them as though we want to retain them so that we can have something against the other person – but this is not the way of the Lord Jesus. Rather, his way is to forgive and to refocus on what St. Ignatius of Loyola would come to call the principal and foundation: "to praise, reverence, and serve God Our Lord, and by doing so, to save his or her soul." To set ourselves aright, we should come before the Lord as necessary in Sacramental Confession, so that he can send us forth to do the work among one another. As we celebrate this Pentecost Sunday, the birth of the Church, as the Holy Spirit is sent from the Father and the Son, let us pray that we will recommit ourselves to this understanding and let peace reign in our hearts.
