
A reflection from the Pastor

"But when he comes, the Spirit of Truth, he will guide you to all truth," Jesus speaking in today's gospel. Today we celebrate the mystery of the Holy Trinity. Jesus tells us today that everything the Father has is also his, and that the Spirit is sent from both of them. It is difficult for us to comprehend this reality; that is why it is a mystery. But, it does not mean we cannot seek to understand the mystery through faith. Pray this week that all your actions and prayers will be directed to the Father, through the Son in the Holy Spirit.
