"The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you," Jesus in today's gospel. How often do we really reflect on the fact that we have the Holy Spirit on our side, to advocate for us and for those who have no voice? And yet, this is the message Jesus wants us to hear today. When we feel as though there is no further hope, it is the wings of the Holy Spirit that shores us up and allows us to soar again to the love of Jesus. A modern day example is that sometimes we want to quantify the gift of faith; I can't learn my prayers, I don't say my prayers enough, I am not worthy or strong enough (I'm only one person) to do that work in the Church – but when we do that we in essence refuse the gift that Jesus gave us – the Holy Spirit. Tap into the power of the Spirit today. As we approach Pentecost – pray the novena asking that you might increase your faith in the Holy Spirit.

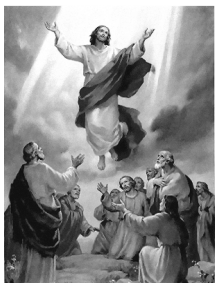

completed the work of our redemption. The terms used in the West, *ascensio* and, occasionally, *ascensa*, signify that Christ was raised up by His own powers.

Pentecost Novena

Begins Friday, May 14th

The origin of novenas, these nine days commemorate the intense prayer of Mary and the apostles from the time of Jesus' ascension into Heaven until the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.

Make time each day to pray the following prayer, in preparation for Pentecost.

ACT OF CONSECRATION TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

On my knees I before the great multitude of heavenly witnesses I offer myself, soul and body to You, Eternal Spirit of God. I adore the brightness of Your purity, the unerring keenness of Your justice, and the might of Your love. You are the Strength and Light of my soul. In You I live and move and am. I desire never to grieve You by unfaithfulness to grace and I pray with all my heart to be kept from the smallest sin against You. Mercifully guard my every thought and grant that I may always watch for Your light, and listen to Your voice, and follow Your gracious inspirations. I cling to You and give myself to You and ask You, by Your compassion to watch over me in my weakness. Holding the pierced Feet of Jesus and looking at His Five Wounds, and trusting in His Precious Blood and adoring His opened Side and stricken Heart, I implore You, Adorable Spirit, Helper of my infirmity, to keep me in Your grace that I may never sin against You. Give me grace O Holy Spirit, Spirit of the Father and the Son to say to You always and everywhere, "Speak Lord for Your servant is listening." Amen.

PRAYER FOR THE SEVEN GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

O Lord Jesus Christ Who, before ascending into heaven did promise to send the Holy Spirit to finish Your work in the souls of Your Apostles and Disciples, deign to grant the same Holy Spirit to me that He may perfect in my soul, the work of Your grace and Your love. Grant me the Spirit of Wisdom that I may despise the perishable things of this world and aspire only after the things that are eternal, the Spirit of Understanding to enlighten my mind with the light of Your divine truth, the Spirit on Counsel that I may ever choose the surest way of pleasing God and gaining heaven, the Spirit of Fortitude that I may bear my cross with You and that I may overcome with courage all the obstacles that oppose my salvation, the Spirit of Knowledge that I may know God and know myself and grow perfect in the science of the Saints, the Spirit of Piety that I may find the service of God sweet and amiable, and the Spirit of Fear that I may be filled with a loving reverence towards God and may dread in any way to displease Him. Mark me, dear Lord with the sign of Your true disciples, and animate me in all things with Your Spirit. Amen.
