**ST. CECILIA,
Virgin and
Martyr**

Devotion to St. Cecilia (to whom a basilica in Rome was built in the 5th Century) grew because of a dramatic and popular narrative of her tortures and death. There seems to be some foundation for the narrative, though the details cannot be shown as factual. The story says that "Cecilia sang in her heart while the musical instruments sounded for her wedding." Because of this, Cecilia is Patroness of Music.



**St. Clement I,
Pope and
Martyr**

November 23

After the obscure pontificates of Linus and Cletus, Clement was the first noted successor of Peter as Bishop of Rome. St. Irenaeus states that Clement knew the Apostles and was strongly influenced by them. Clement wrote a Scripturally based letter to the Corinthians (dated around 95) encouraging them to unity, charity and holiness. He is believed to have suffered martyrdom around 100. The ancient, lovely basilica of St. Clement in Rome is probably built on the site of Clement's home.
