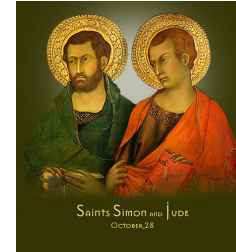

### October 28 Sts. Simon and Jude, apostles

Today we celebrate the feast of two apostles. The name Simon is eleventh on the list of the Twelve. It is known that Simon came from Cana and was called Zealot – perhaps a member of the activist political party against Roman occupation of Judea. The apostle Jude, called Thaddaeus, spoke with Jesus during the Last Supper (Jn 14:22). In lists of the Apostles these two are always together.
