August 23rd,
St. Rose of Lima,
Virgin

Born in Lima, Peru, in 1586 of Spanish descent, Isabella de Olivia, because of her reddish complexion, was called Rose by all. An intelligent and efficient girl, she took St. Catherine of Siena as her model. At 15 Rose received the habit of a Third Order Dominican. In obedience to her parents Rose did not enter the convent, but lived at home a humble life of penance and mystical prayer. Rose of Lima died in 1617 when 31 years of age, on August 24. She is the first saint of the Americas.



August 24th,
St. Bartholomew,
Apostle

One of the twelve foundation stones of the Church, this Apostle was born at Cana in Galilee. He was brought to Jesus by Philip. Tradition holds that after the Ascension he preached the Gospel in India and there met martyrdom. Because of differing lists of the Twelve Bartholomew is usually identified with the Nathanael described in the Fourth Gospel.
