**St. Hilary, bishop
and doctor**

Hilary was born towards the start of the 4th century at Poitiers in France. Married and father of a saintly daughter named Abia, Hilary was converted to the Christian faith by reading the Scriptures, especially the Prologue to the Fourth Gospel. As Bishop of Poitiers, he fought against the Arians, suffered exile, wrote extensively and helped his people. He died in 367.
