## Saints of the Week



July 23<sup>rd</sup>,  
St. James,  
Apostle

Son of Zebedee and brother of John the Evangelist-Apostle, today's saint was born at Bethsaida in Galilee. He was present at the special miracles worked by the Lord. The first apostle to die, James was martyred by Herod Agrippa 1 in 43 or 44 (Acts 12:2). Known as James the Greater because of his status, he has been specially honored since the ninth century at Compostella in Spain. From this famous place of pilgrimage his cult was carried especially to Latin America – where many cities are named Santiago.



July 30<sup>th</sup>,  
St. Peter Chrysologus,  
Bishop and Doctor

Called Chrysologus ("golden worded") because of his eloquence, today's saint was born near Ravenna in Italy around 480. Elected bishop of Ravenna when that Kingdom was at its strongest, Peter 1 was an effective, dedicated pastoral leader. He preached briefly and preached much. Some 180 of his sermons still exist. They show him to have been a direct, warm, convincing speaker. Bishop Peter 1 died on a July 30, between 451 and 458.
