St. Anthony of Padua,
Priest and Doctor

Born in Lisbon, Portugal, in 1195 and baptized Fernando, today's saint became an Augustinian priest. In admiration of Franciscans recently martyred in Morocco, he joined the Franciscans, took the name Anthony and in 1221 joined St. Francis in Assisi. Anthony preached throughout France and north Italy, especially against the Cathari heresy. He died at Padua in Italy at age 36. His influence on Catholic life has been considerable.

St. Romuald,
Abbot

Romuald, son of the Duke of Ravenna, was born in that illustrious city around the year 950. A follower of Benedict but called to the solitary hermit's life, he used to live as a hermit near Benedictine monasteries so as to join the monks in liturgical prayer. At Comaldi in the Appennine mountains he founded the Order of the Hermit Camaldolese monks. A follower of his could live as a monk, or as a hermit with liturgical prayer with monks, or as a complete solitary. In 1027 Romuald died in solitude.
