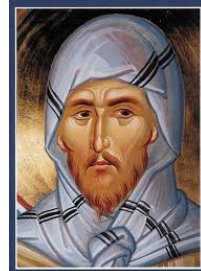

June 6th
St. Norbert,
Bishop

Born in Germany, Norbert led an undisciplined life until dramatically converted to Christ (1115). He started a life of penance, was ordained a priest and began preaching to priests of his day. Norbert then went to a forested area in France called Premontre. There he started a religious order, called Premonstratensians, dedicated to advancing the holiness of priestly life. Made Archbishop of Magdeburg, Norbert continued his efforts for holiness and renewal in the Church. He died in 1134.



June 9th,
St. Ephrem,
Deacon and Doctor

Ephrem was born around 306 at Nisibis (now in Turkey), and became a deacon in the Syrian Church. Later transferred to Edessa in Mesopotamia, Ephrem instructed others in theology. He combined contemplation, discipline and catechetical instruction. Ephrem was a poet who used poetry to teach religious truths. He is called the "harp of the Holy Spirit." In 363 he ended a life filled with love for Christ and the Virgin Mary.
