**Tuesday, Oct. 18th** – There will be a **Finance Committee meeting at 7:00 p.m.** in the conference room. Please make plans to attend.

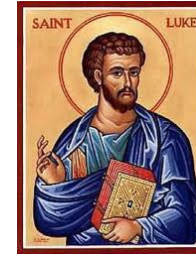

Paul Francis Danei (1694-1775) was born in Italy, labored in commerce and military service, and then dedicated his life to meditating on the mystery of Christ's cross and to evangelizing the countryside. In 1720 he became a solitary-praying several hours a day, practicing mortification, planning a religious community. Ordained a priest, he preached effectively, saw the Passionist rule approved by the Holy See in 1741 and adopted the name of the Paul of the Cross. The Passionists developed steadily. An order of women was begun in 1771. On October 18, 1775, he died in Rome, at the ancient Basilica of Sts. John and Paul. Paul of the Cross was canonized a saint in 1867. The ideals and work of the Passionist Orders continue to advance the Church.
