St. Wenceslaus,
Martyr

Born in Bohemia around 907, today's saint at a young age became the ruling Duke of Bohemia. In a court almost pagan, Wenceslaus showed himself a devout Catholic Christian. He demonstrated love for the poor, devotion to Mary, a spirit of penance, a desire to build up religion. This contributed to his assassination in 935. Wenceslaus is the national patron saint of Bohemia.



September 29th,
Sts. Michael, Gabriel
and Raphael,
Archangels

Scripture contains many references to angels. Special biblical attention is paid to Michael (Protector of the People of God), Gabriel (Messenger of the Annunciation to Mary) and Raphael (the Healer in the Book of Tobit). Today's date recalls a basilica northeast of Rome dedicated during the fifth Century, honoring St. Michael the Archangel.
