Saints of the Week



September 27th,
St. Vincent De Paul,
Priest

Today we recall the magnificent life of the Saint of Charity, the totally dedicated little "Monsieur Vincent" (1581-1660). A parish priest near Paris, he developed the apostolate of fighting all physical and moral evils of his time. The galley slaves, abandoned babies, prostitutes, victims of war, de-christianized poor – all came under his mantle of generous care. He died on this date in 1660 and was canonized a saint in 1737. The patron of all charitable societies, Vincent de Paul's life and ideal of charity still inspire the Church.



October 1st,
St. Theresa of the Child
of Jesus,
Virgin

Today's saint is the popular "little Flower of Jesus" (1873-1897). Marie Theresa Martin, devout from childhood, by special permission entered the cloistered Carmelites of Lisieux in France at age 15. She developed a spiritual approach of striving for perfection by being a child of God. At age 24 she died in profoundly spiritual fashion. Her autobiography, "The Story of a Soul", helped to make her popular in the following years. She was canonized a saint in 1925.
