## Saints of the Week



April 2<sup>nd</sup>,  
St. Francis of Paola,  
Hermit

Today's saint was born (1416) in Paola of Calabria, in the rugged southern part of Italy. At an early age Francis became a hermit. The more he left society, the more people came to see his sanctity and miracles. A community developed around him: the Order of the Little Ones. The Pope asked Francis to come to Rome, and later to go to France, to teach others the ways and example of holiness. An ambassador of spirituality, Francis died in France on this date, Good Friday in 1507. He was canonized a saint in 1519.



April 7<sup>th</sup>,  
St. Isidore,  
Bishop and Doctor

Isidore was one of a family of saints. Born around 560 in Seville, Spain, he succeeded his brother Leandro as Bishop of Seville. The times were difficult: it was the Kingdom of the Visigoths; the Church needed organization. Isidore organized with zeal-through his preaching, education of youth, writing, synodal legislation. Through 33 years he labored to build up a Christian community. He died in 636.
