Saints of the Week



April 23rd,
St. George,
Martyr

During the Easter Season the Church delights in remembering her martyrs, victors with risen Christ. In the Fourth Century, in Palestine, George was venerated as a soldier who courageously gave up his life for the faith. The cult of this saint spread through the Near East and into Europe. At the time of the Crusades St. George was chosen as patron saint of England.



April 24th,
St. Fidelis of Sigmaringen,
Priest and Martyr

The martyr is a witness to the tragic times of the Reformation, when Christians killed other Christians in the name of Christ. Born in Sigmaringen, Germany, in 1578, Fidelis became a Capuchin. As superior of different monasteries Fidelis showed himself charitable and zealous. Sent by the Propagation of the Faith to preach to Protestants. Fidelis was killed in 1622 by Swiss fanatics. He was canonized a saint in 1746.
