Saints of the Week



February 6th,
Sts. Paul Miki and
Companions,
Martyrs

Today's memorial reminds us of the Church's universality. Nagasaki in Japan, target of an atomic bomb in 1945, was the city where 26 Catholics were crucified on February 5, 1597. They were Japanese and Europeans; Jesuits, Franciscans and laity. Their martyrdom, with today's saint encouraging and preaching from his cross, was truly heroic. Canonized as saints in 1862, they remind us of the many martyrs and saints of the Far East.



February 10th,
St. Scholastica,
Virgin

Today's saint was the twin sister of Benedict, founder of the Benedictine Order. She lived in a century and country full of difficulties—during the 6th Century in central Italy, when armies of Goths and Byzantines criss-crossed the land and repeatedly terrorized the people. Scholastica demonstrated her holiness, peace and strength. Rivaling her brother in holiness, Scholastica died in 547.
