Saints of the Week



July 25th,
St. James,
Apostle

Son of Zebedee and brother of John the Evangelist-Apostle, today's saint was born at Bethsaida in Galilee. He was present at the special miracles worked by the Lord. The first apostle to die, James was martyred by Herod Agrippa I in 43 or 44 (Acts 12:2). Known as James the Greater because of his status, he has been specially honored since the ninth century at Compostella in Spain. From this famous place of pilgrimage his cult was carried especially to Latin America-where many cities are named Santiago.

Sts. Joachim and Ann,
Parents of Mary

An ancient tradition, going back to the first half of the 2nd century, identifies the parents of Mary as Joachim and Ann. In the 6th Century at Constantinople a basilica was dedicated to St. Ann. The grandparents of Jesus were honored in Jerusalem: a church of St. Ann has existed there since Crusader times. Many Catholics have visited Ste. Anne de Beaupre in Canada, where the Patroness of Christian Mothers is specially revered.
