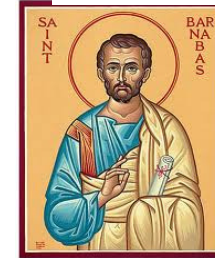

Saints of the Week



June 11th,
St. Barnabas,
Apostle

One of the apostolic men of the New Testament, Barnabas was born on Cyprus. His name was Joseph. Converted shortly after Pentecost, he gave up all possessions and received the name Barnabas ("son of consolation") because of his helpful, optimistic nature. Barnabas assisted the newly converted Paul and accompanied him for a while on the first missionary journey. Tradition says that Barnabas was martyred in Cyprus during the 60's.



June 13th,
St. Anthony of Padua,
Priest and Doctor

Born in Lisbon, Portugal, in 1195 and baptized Fernando, today's saint became an Augustinian priest. In admiration of Franciscans recently martyred in Morocco, he joined the Franciscans, took the name Anthony and in 1221 joined St. Francis in Assisi. Anthony preached throughout France and north Italy, especially against the Cathari heresy. He died at Padua in Italy at age 36. His influence on Catholic life has been considerable.
