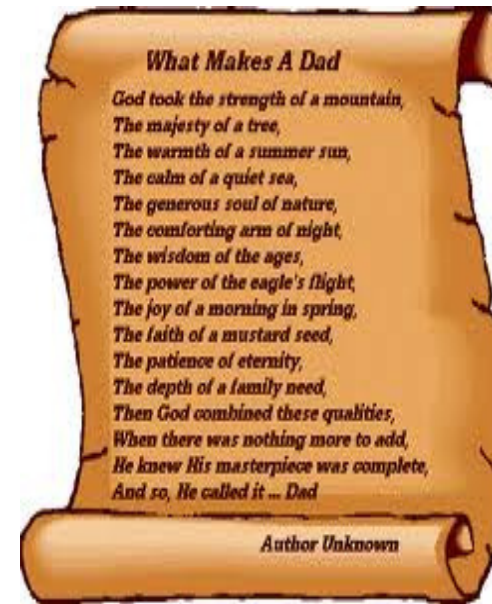

## Saints of the Week



June 19<sup>th</sup>,  
St. Romuald,  
Abbot

Romuald, son of the Duke of Ravenna, was born in that illustrious city around the year 950. A follower of Benedict but called to the solitary hermit's life, he used to live as a hermit near Benedictine monasteries so as to join the monks in liturgical prayer. At Comaldi in the Appennine mountains he founded the Order of the Hermit Camaldolese monks. A follower of his could live as a monk, or as a hermit with liturgical prayer with monks, or as a complete solitary. In 1027 Romuald died in solitude.



June 22<sup>nd</sup>,  
St. Paulinus of Nola,  
Bishop

Paulinus was born at Bordeaux, France, around 353. He was named Roman Consul of the area, acquired vast territories, became very rich, was married and had a child. Desiring a better life he gave away all possessions to the poor and with his wife moved to Nola, near Naples. In 409 the people of Nola elected him bishop. For 22 years the old consul turned Shepherd governed his people well, helped the miserable ones, encouraged all his people in the face of barbarian invasions. Paulinus died in 431.
