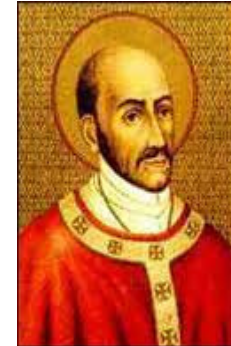
\*\* **Reminder to all CCD Students:** Classes will resume this Wednesday, March 21<sup>st</sup>. All students should report to the church for Penitential service.

St. Turibius de Mongrovejo,  
Bishop

Today's saint was a heroic, hard-working bishop who did much to organize the Church in Latin America. Born in Spain in 1538, he was named Archbishop of Lima in 1581. There were then enormous problems in the Latin American Missions: religious, social, political problems. He began a systematic visitation of his huge diocese, to correct abuses and to build up the faith. He used to say: "Jesus Christ did not say 'I am the custom', but 'I am the Truth.'" He died on a visitation in 1606 and was canonized a saint in 1726.
