November 12th,
St. Josephat,
Bishop and Martyr

Today's saint is a martyr and patron for reunion of the Greek and Latin Churches. Born in Poland in 1580 as an Orthodox, he became a Catholic and then a monk and priest of the Order of St. Basil. He became archimandrite and later Archbishop of Poloz. A zealous bishop and worker for Christian unity, in 1623 Josaphat was assassinated by enemies while making a pastoral visitation. He was canonized a saint in 1867.



November 16th,
St. Margaret of Scotland

Today's saint was born in Hungary around 1046 while her father was in political exile from William the Conqueror. The family returned to England and then Scotland, where Margaret married King Malcolm in 1070. Margaret was an ideal queen-devoted to her illiterate husband and eight children, concerned for charity and religion, helping the poor people of Scotland. She died at Edinburgh in 1093, four days after Malcolm had been killed.
