October 7th,
Our Lady of the Rosary

Today's memorial recalls the crucial victory of Christian Europe over the Moslems at the naval battle of Lepanto – October 7, 1571. The victory was attributed to the Blessed Mother, invoked through the Rosary prayer. This memorial however is not of a past event. It reminds us of meditation on the mysteries of Christ with the help of Mary. Such meditation is connected with the incarnation, sufferings and glorious Resurrection of the Son of God.

St. Callistus I,
Pope and Martyr

In 217 Callistus, having been a slave, was ordained deacon to Pope Zephyrinus, and then succeeded him as Pope. Callistus systematized the first official Christian cemetery in Rome, on the Appian Way. There for a century the Popes were buried. Those catacombs are still known by the name of St. Callistus. He had to battle several heresies before martyrdom in 222. In 1960 his tomb was discovered in Rome.
