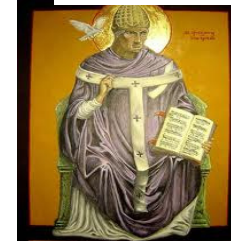
Auction Items – We are in need of Auction items for our Turkey Festival. If you have items to donate, you may drop them off at the church with Father Sam. All items are happily accepted.

Saints of the Week



September 3rd,
St. Gregory the Great,
Pope and Doctor

Born in Rome around 540, Gregory was a senator and civic administrator who at age 35 entered the Benedictine monastery. After five years he was legate to Constantinople, and on this date in 590 became Pope. For 14 years he worked in incomparable fashion-guiding the Church in decadent times, facing the Lombard invasions, sending out missionaries, writing, advancing the liturgy. Gregorian chant is named for him. One of the greatest Popes in centuries, equal to the crises of his age, Gregory the Great died in 604.



September 8th,
Birth of Mary

Since the 6th Century in Jerusalem the birthplace of Mary has been venerated. In the 12th Century this place became the Church of St. Anne. In a real sense, Mary's birth prepared for the Redemption. The nine month span between December 8 and today's feast is to be noted.
